

WPC Fishing Derby Rules 2019

- 1. By entering the WPC Fishing Derby all participants declare that they have an understanding of all tournament rules and agree to abide by them.
- 2. You are responsible for your safety and actions at all times before, during and after the WPC Fishing Derby . Each entrant, upon registration to compete in the derby, agrees that he will not hold the Sponsors or Hosts liable for any kind of accident that might occur during the WPC Fishing Derby .
- 3. Payment of \$20 can be made online or at the event
- 4. Registration is valid ONLY after payment is received.
- 5. All BC fishing regulations must be abided by or you may be disqualified.
- 6. All regulations set forth by Transport Canada must be abided by. Boat owners MUST comply with all safety requirements and have their PCOC certification as per Transport Canada regulations.
- 7. All Participants must carry their ticket with them at all times
- 8. If you have people on board that don't have a ticket and won't be fishing, please email us and let us know ahead of time for approval sjohnson@willowparkchurch.com. Prior approval must be granted by the organizers. We will have spotters on the lake to make sure it is fair for everybody.
- 9. Your ticket entitles you to only ONE line in the water.
- 10. If you cannot attend the WPC Fishing Derby, you must notify us 1 day prior to the event
- 11. The WPC Fishing Derby will commence at 8:00am on June 15th, 2019 and end at 5:00pm on the same day. Last measurement eligible 5:00pm on June 15th, 2019. **No exceptions.**
- 12. **Official Measuring**: Once a fish is caught, the participant is responsible for measuring their catch and taking a legible photo that shows the exact length. Fish will be measured in INCHES from the tip of the head to the fork in the centre of the tail to the nearest eighth of an inch.. Once this is done you may release your fish. Upon completion of the derby and before 5:00pm you must provide photographic proof of your measured fish. It will be up to the Derby judge to confirm the photo was done correctly and that the fish is in fact the length as stated. If there is a discrepancy between the called in length and photographic length of the fish the derby entrant will place in the event as per the Derby Judge deems appropriate.
- 13. The fish will be measured in **INCHES** from the tip of the head to the fork in the centre of the tail to the nearest *eighth of an inch* and will be recorded appropriately. LONGEST fish wins.
- 14. In the case of a tie, the entrants will participate in a coin toss "Best 2 out of 3."
 15. All decisions of the Derby Judge are final and may not be protested.
