FREE TIME

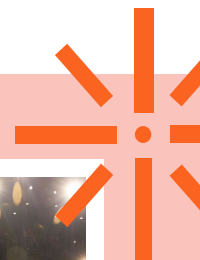
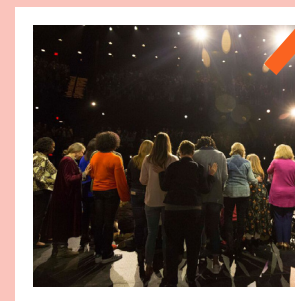
