

Spring Break Kids Camp COVID-19- POLICY

Practises, Protocol and Logistics

Based on current Provincial health mandate February 5 of no groups large then 50

Volunteers

Before program begins

- Child protection training done over Zoom/in person ensuring CRC checks and general CP training
- Covid-19 training done over zoom/in person specific training regarding below COVID-19 protocols and expectations
- Volunteer 2:12 ratio

During program

- Volunteers will wear masks at all times
- Volunteers will commit to daily wellness checks
- Volunteers experiencing any symptoms, those who have been in contact with probable or confirmed case, or have travelled outside the country will stay home
- Volunteers will help with implementation of program and cleaning/sanitization

Covid-19:

General

- Covid-19 Regulations limit group size to less then 50
- Plan to have 2 locations in building used Auditorium and Balcony groups will never mix or be in contact with each other
- With each location broken down into 4 groups of 12-13 children and 2 volunteers
- Program flow on chart attached
- Regular Hand washing and Sanitization stations will be located through out the area and will be encouraged and mandated by volunteers
- Also using Upper Room, Lobby, Fireside Room and Gym for secondary room locations
- Kids will use tables as workstations* when in Upper Room, Gym, Lobby, Fire Side Rooms
- Children will be highly encouraged to wear masks through the program even though they are not mandatory.
- Auditorium and Balcony seating will be by group marker by seat Section and Physically distanced
- Groups will move between designated rooms (flow chart attached)
 - Groups will be dismissed from main areas using staggered times to ensure clear hallways
- Separate entrance and exits and washroom facilities for each room location.
- Station Leaders will always wear a mask and will not break the recommended Physical Distancing parameters of 3 meters
- Washroom will be used following Child protection Policies

- Washrooms and high touch surfaces will be cleaned and sanitized regularly through out the morning

Registration/Check In/ Pick Up

- Online registration only no walk ins, NO EXCEPTIONS
- Families and friend requests will be met to the best of our ability -These groups will be the start of our groups
- Group members will not change through out the program and families will be directed to the appropriate entrances and rooms prior to start of program
- On Arrival Parents will complete wellness check of each child
- Volunteers will direct children to their group
- Parents will then exit out exit doors
- Each Room location will have a designated exit for Pick up
- parents will pick up by waiting outside the marked/designated doors where children will be dismissed in a safe way to parents or caregivers

Worship

- Worship leaders will demonstrate and model safe physical distancing of 3 meters

Games (Gym and Upper Room)

- Games will only be playing within the groups- No Mixing of groups
 - Individual games in a round robin style
 - Minute to win it like – junk in the trunk, cookie face, suck it up, stack attack, moving on up, penny hose, keep it up
 - Competition style games placing group verse group ensuring no contact or sharing of supplies between cohorts

Bible Story/Lesson components (Main Auditorium)

- Will occur in Auditorium
- Groups will return to there designated seating section
- Seating at Physical distance way

Craft- secondary locations

- Group will be seated at there designated location at a table
- Inside the space children will sit at tables that are safely spaced (2 meters) as required by the Public Health order
- Craft leader will lead from front with a minimum 3- meter distance to nearest child with kids completing crafts at their workstations.
- Individual bags of markers, scissors glue will be used for each child
- Craft supplies will be handed out by group volunteers or placed in bags for easy distribution inside the group
- Group Volunteers will wear masks and assist children as needed

Snack – secondary location

- Will be eaten at their work stations
- Will be individually portioned and handed out to students at workstations
- When possible, prewrapped snacks will be used like cheese strings, apple sauce, pudding, yogurt, granola bars

Science Station Secondary location

- groups will be seated in designated area
- Science leader will lead from front with a minimum 3-meter distance to nearest child with kids completing crafts at their workstations.
- Individual bags of markers, scissors glue will be used for each child
- Science supplies will be handed out by group volunteers or placed in bags for easy distribution inside the group
- Group Volunteers will wear masks and assist children as needed

Cleaning/Sanitization

- Orange sanitization buckets containing cleaning supplies will be placed in every room
- High tough surfaces light switches, doorknobs will be washed then sprayed with disinfectant regularly through out the day
- Work surfaces like tables, chairs mats will be cleaned following every group
- Work Mats will be set up for each child to use repeatedly through the day and they will be sanitized at end of each day
- Reusable supplies will be cleaned and sanitized and put away the following morning after drying
- Any paper or disposable items will be placed in the garbage/ recycling
- Bathrooms will be cleaned regularly through the day
